Phase 1 Basic Reopening Guidelines

- Observe social distancing of 6 ft.
- Wear face mask covering both nose and mouth
- Hand sanitizers will be available
- Ushers will guide seating to designated spots
- Those currently living in the same household can sit together
- Parents are responsible for their children
- The Kitchen, Fellowship Hall, and all Classrooms are closed
- Only 1 at a time in each restroom
- Children's church will move to their new location in the fellowship hall. Children can also participate remotely via Zoom Meeting at 11AM
